

Sustainability Support

After our initial WA PREP contract ends, we continue to provide our partners with the following support services to help sustain comprehensive sexual health education (CSHE) implementation.

Educator Support

Sustainability partners will continue to receive professional development opportunities for teachers and facilitators.

- Core Skills eLearning Modules & Refresher Training: We will provide up to 4, 2-hour virtual Core Skills Refresher trainings for teachers and facilitators.
 The refresher course serves as an annual follow-up to the hybrid 6-hour Core Skills training. Sustainability partners will continue to have access to the Core Skills eLearning modules for facilitators to reference as desired. New CSHE facilitators can join the hybrid 6-hour Core Skills training hosted by the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) in the Fall.
- Curriculum Office Hours: We will host up to 4, 2-hour virtual office hour appointments to provide an overview of the selected curriculum, help troubleshoot implementation challenges, and answer facilitator questions.
- Supplemental Trainings: Sustainability partners can select 2 of the 2-hour virtual trainings.
- Key Content eLearning
 Modules: Sustainability partners will
 have access to the full range of self-paced
 Key Content eLearning modules.

Parent/Caregiver Support

Sustainability partners will continue to receive the full range of parent/caregiver support.

- CSHE Informational Presentation: A
 customized recorded presentation to
 inform parents/caregivers in the school
 community about CSHE legislative
 requirements and policies, the curriculum
 selected, and the implementation plan at
 the district.
- "How to talk with young people about sexual health" Presentation: A recorded presentation designed to build parents/caregivers' comfort with having conversations about sexual health with young people in their life.
- "The Talk" eLearning modules:
 eLearning micro-modules to guide age appropriate conversations between
 caregivers and youth about topics related
 to CSHE.
- Q&A: Our staff will respond to a google survey where parents/caregivers can submit questions about CSHE.
- Resources: A list of reliable books and websites regarding CSHE related topics as well as reflection worksheets designed to help guide caregivers in their conversations with young people.
